





2021 Construction Career Camp Season SUCCESS

AGC's 2021 Construction Career Camp season was a success for members & students! Camp sponsorships broke a record with over \$20,000 raised in funding from 38 sponsors, in addition to 24 exceptionally generous in-kind donors who all played a part in this year's events. We made an impact on almost 500 students with four camps held in Yankton, Aberdeen, Sioux Falls and Pierre.

AGC will wrap up the 2021-2022 year with one spring camp which will be held in Rapid City. In addition, a Pizza, Pop and Powertools event for middle-school aged girls will be held in Sioux Falls. Careers in Construction Month

AGC of SD along with Governor Kristi Noem via an Executive Proclamation, is proud to proclaim October 2021 as "Careers in Construction Month" across South Dakota! As an essential industry, the key aspect of our on-going workforce development goal is to show students career opportunities available in construction. With the ever-growing need for skilled professionals in the construction industry, there has never been a better time for education and industry to work together to help students build successful construction career pathways that are stable and rewarding.

AGC of SD + SDDOT Work Together to Create CDL Driver Solutions

Working in collaboration with the SDDOT, the AGC of SD is establishing a sustainable training provider system for our members and SDDOT employees; as well as working to encourage and impact the number of individuals who may be interested in entering the construction industry as a CDL driver. New mandates from the FMCSA will require new drivers to attend a formal training program to become licensed effective February 7, 2022. To address this, AGC of SD is registered with the Training Provider Registry with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. We are recognized on the DLR Eligible Training Provider List for apprenticeships - we should be able to add CDL as well when we are ready. This designation will qualify AGC for training dollars we otherwise wouldn't qualify for. In addition, we have identified an instructor and are working on identifying and training additional instructors across the state. AGC is currently in the process of scheduling a workgroup meeting to review curriculum and marketing of program as well as time line for rollout.

Legalization of Marijuana in the Workplace Resources & Member Feedback Needed



LEGISLATIVE NEWS

Election Year is Near

In November of 2022, South Dakotans will elect all legislative seats, the governor, and all other statewide offices. CONPAC is planning now to elect businessfriendly candidates to office. Once candidate petitions are filed in March 2022, CONPAC will compile a candidate list complete with voting records if applicable. That list will be shared with CONPAC members who will add their intel. Based on what we gather, campaign contributions will be set and CONPAC members will begin delivering campaign contributions around early July 2022. CONPAC is also watching the petition process regarding initiated measures and will discuss any that impact business in South Dakota. Special Session on Redistricting – Know your District, Know your Legislators

States are required to redraw legislative districts every ten years, based on the most recent census data. South Dakota legislators met in special session in November to debate a variety of maps that would redraw legislative districts to fit federal census guidelines. After nearly three days, they passed a bill which was signed by Governor Noem. The new districts will be in effect for the 2022 elections. When available, AGC will share a link to the new districts so members can see if their district, and legislators, will change.

Legislative Summer Study Committees Concluded

Each year the legislature votes on topics to research through the use of summer studies or task forces. AGC spent the summer monitoring these legislative study committees:

Medical and Adult Use Marijuana – the committee agreed to draft 27 bills to tweak the medical and adult use marijuana measures passed by voters in 2020. AGC was gratified that the changes proposed are favorable to business owners. However, the only constant with the topic of marijuana is change. And this bill package will definitely change. AGC knows of at least 50 additional bills that will be introduced to further shape marijuana use in South Dakota. Marijuana will clearly take up much of the legislature's bandwidth. AGC will monitor all marijuana legislative activity closely to ensure the rights of business owners are protected.

Workforce Housing Needs – this committee explored

the need for affordable workforce housing and how to make building/ financing these housing



projects more attractive. The committee will introduce a package of bills to accomplish this goal. AGC will analyze the bills when they are available and circulate them with the Legislative Committee for discussion and input.

<u>COVID Liaison Committee/Appropriations</u> – nearly \$1 billion in federal coronavirus relief funding will be available to boost infrastructure projects that will fund drinking water, sewage and other projects in South Dakota over the next five years.

The money is available because of the State, Local, Tribal, and Territorial Fiscal Recovery, Infrastructure, and Disaster Relief Flexibility Act (S. 3011). S. 3001 has passed the U.S. Senate by unanimous consent and now awaits action in the U.S. House. This act intends to amend ARPA and provide greater flexibility in how State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund dollars may be spent. The total amount of money a state may spend on infrastructure projects would be 30 percent of its total allocation, which for South Dakota would be about \$292 million. For localities, the amount they may spend would be the greater of 30 percent of their total allocation or \$10 million. Thus, in South Dakota, counties would be able to spend about \$132 million (out of \$172 million) and metropolitan cities (Rapid City and Sioux Falls) would be able to spend \$20 million (out of \$38 million) on infrastructure. Funding for infrastructure projects would have to be obligated by December 31, 2024 and spent by September 30, 2026. States must use this funding to supplement, not supplant, other infrastructure spending.

2022 Legislative Session

The 97th Session of the South Dakota Legislature begins on January 11, 2022. AGC will again be represented during session to protect the interests of the construction industry. Legislation will begin to be introduced in December and will continue until February 3, 2022. All bills of interest to the construction industry will be analyzed and circulated for discussion and input by the Legislative Committee. In addition, AGC hosts weekly Zoom calls during session to further discuss bills and all that is happening at the Capitol. Join us for the first one on Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. CT.

Vaccine Mandate – A Hobson's Choice For Federal Contractors

On September 9, 2021, Executive Order 14042 ("EO") was signed by the President of the United States. It requires federal contractors and subcontractors to comply with the guidance established by the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force. The Task Force provided Guidance on September 24, 2021, and updated Guidance on November 10, 2021 ("Guidance"). It contains many specific requirements regarding masking and social distancing, as well as an overall vaccine mandate for federal contractors and subcontractors. All covered contractor employees must be fully vaccinated by January 18, 2022.

There are two exemptions specifically mentioned. One is for medical conditions. The other is for a "sincerely held religious belief, practice, or observance." Compliance with the exemption for medical conditions should be straight forward. Compliance with the exemption for religious beliefs is more complicated. The Guidance does not provide any assistance in that regard. The Guidance does not indicate how an employer would know if a belief is actually religious in nature or if it is sincerely held. The Guidance does not state whether an employer can or should request proof to support the claim of a religious exemption or what level of proof would be sufficient.

The Guidance is vague and it may conflict with other federal laws and regulations regarding religious discrimination. Religious discrimination is illegal under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act. Federal regulations define religion broadly. For example, a "religious practice" includes "moral or ethical beliefs as to what is right and wrong." 29 CFR 1605.1. Given this broad standard, federal contractors are placed in the precarious position of choosing between compliance with the government's vaccine mandate on the one hand and the risk of a civil rights lawsuit on the other. The EEOC has recently issued new guidance in an attempt to embolden federal contractors to challenge weak claims of religious exemption by employees, but that doesn't insulate the employer from a lawsuit or the consequence of being incorrect.

Assuming an employer accepts a claim of exemption by an employee, there are more problems. The Guidance does not dictate the nature of the "reasonable accommodation" that must be made when an employee claims a religious exemption. It appears to be a case by case basis. Is it enough to require exempt employees to wear a mask and socially distance? Is periodic testing enough? Can unvaccinated employees continue working on the federal work site?

Given all the foregoing, lawsuits seem likely.

AGC-Backed Bipartisan Infrastructure Signed into I aw

In mid-November, President Biden signed the AGC-backed Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill, also known as the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), into law. This was all possible thanks to the efforts by AGC and its members—sending nearly 100,000 messages to Congress—to push it over the top. The IIJA is the most significant infusion of investment in our infrastructure since the enactment of the Interstate Highway System in the mid-1950's. It provides market opportunities for transportation contractors, heavy contractors, building contractors and utility contractors. And, it demonstrates to our existing and future workforce that there is sustainable work in the years to come. 
