



Spring Load Limit Restrictions Announced

SDDOT recently released their 2023 Proposed Spring Load Limit Restrictions Map. Spring Load Restrictions in South Dakota can be placed

on state and county highways and roads between February 15 - April 30, 2023. It is the Department's position to not implement Spring Load Restrictions any earlier than necessary. The Department monitors the daily high/low temperatures at numerous locations throughout the state. The Department still relies heavily on the existing highway conditions and past experience of its field personnel when making the final decision of when to implement and remove load restrictions. 

LEGISLATIVE NEWS

Midpoint Session Report

The halfway mark of the 2023 Legislative Session is near, and AGC has a dozen bills of interest on their bill tracker. Here is a synopsis of those bills by topics:

Protecting Highway Funding

Senate Bill 215 proposes to take money from the highway fund to develop water pipelines. AGC is working with the bill sponsor to see if she can rework the bill.

Restraints on Business

AGC helped to defeat a bill that would have bogged down work comp system by requiring unneeded communications; turned back a proposal for a wage scale on all government funded projects, and defeated a proposed salary and benefit posting/reporting requirement.

A Rare Tax Break

Due to the health of the Reemployment Trust Fund, the state was able to offer a third tax table with the lowest reemployment tax premiums to date. AGC and others businesses supported passage of this bill.

More Tax Breaks

There are three proposals working their way through the process that would lower the state tax rate from 4.5 cents to 4 cents; repeal the state sales tax on groceries and eliminate the first \$100,000 in valuation from levies for single-family, owner-occupied homes. AGC knows that tax breaks sometimes result in tax shifts, so we are watching these bills closely.

More on Medical Marijuana


Impairment ratings for marijuana users remain elusive, but AGC is working with legislators to find a solution.

Eminent Domain/Pipelines

The proposed carbon capture pipeline has caused an uproar among landowners and there are many bills trying to keep private pipelines from being considered common carriers and from using the power of eminent domain. AGC is watching these bills so construction's use of eminent domain is not infringed.

AGC LEGAL MINUTE JASON SMILEY, AGC LEGAL COUNSEL



A recent decision from the South Dakota Supreme court adds some clarity to two issues that come up frequently during construction law disputes. In Suvada v. Muller, 2022 S.D. 75, a contractor who was hired to renovate a cabin commenced action against the cabin's owners

for breach of contract and to foreclose a mechanic's lien for alleged unpaid labor and materials.

One issue the Court considered involved alleged changes to the work. The contractor claimed that the owners changed the siding that was to be installed after the contract was signed. The contractor claimed that the parties verbally modified the agreement to allow the contractor to charge an hourly rate for hours worked over and above the number of hours he estimated it would take to install the siding. The written contract, however, required changes to be made in writing. The contractor argued that under SDCL 53-8-7, an executed verbal agreement can modify a written contract. The Court found the evidence in the record insufficient to overcome the written agreement. There was a lack of evidence that both parties completed the requirements for an oral modification. The contractor admitted that not all the work was completed. Further, the fact that the owner had not paid the contractor for the alleged extra hours was significant. This is true even though there was evidence that the owners had paid the contractor for some extras.

A second issue considered by the Court concerns South Dakota's mechanic's lien laws. A mechanic's lien is an equitable remedy, which typically means the parties do not have a right to a jury trial. In this case, however, it appeared that the parties consented to the jury's consideration of the issue by failing to object to it. The Court found that the trial court could use a jury in an advisory capacity



in any event and the lack of objection resulted in no error. Further on the subject of mechanic's liens, the Court was asked to consider the question of attorney's fees. South Dakota's mechanic's lien statutes allow for the recovery of attorney's fees to the lien claimant. The jury returned a verdict for the contractor on his mechanic's lien; however, the jury returned an even larger verdict for the owners on their counterclaims. The trial court refused to award the attorney's fees to the contractor. According to the Court, it was not in error for the trial court to refuse an award of attorney's fees where the contractor was not the only party that prevailed on its claims.

This case is significant for at least two reasons. First, it stresses the importance of modifying written contracts using an appropriate change order. This is not the only way to modify a contract, but it can be very challenging to prove a change without doing so in writing. Second, the issue of attorney's fees is a big issue in mechanic's lien foreclosure proceedings. Prior case law suggested that attorney's fees may be appropriate regardless of the size of the award to the contractor. The Court's most recent case suggests there may be a limit when there is an award under a counterclaim.

New FHWA Buy America Guidance

On February 1, the Federal Highway Administration issued a new "questions and answers" guidance document addressing



expanded Buy America requirements under the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA). The most important question answered is that cement and asphalt are exempt from BABAA requirements when created or combined with other exempt construction materials (cement and cementitious materials; aggregates such as stone, sand, or gravel; or aggregate binding agents or additives).

However, combining any of the BABAA-exempt materials with any BABAA-covered materials (nonferrous metals, glass, plastics, etc.) would result in a manufactured product subject to BABAA compliance. So, for example, if titanium shavings were added to a cement mix to add strength, the mix would now have to be BABAA compliant as a manufactured product.

It should be noted that FHWA's 1983 final Buy America regulations waive the application of Buy America to manufactured products that do not include steel and iron components (consequently, the waiver extends to this previous example). That stated, Buy America requirements apply to any steel or iron component of a manufactured product regardless of the overall composition of the manufactured product (e.g. Buy America applies to the steel wire mesh or steel reinforcing components of a precast reinforced concrete pipe).

FHWA does note, however, that it plans to publish a notice in the Federal Register soon requesting comments on whether it should rescind or keep its manufactured products waiver.

A critical question that remains unanswered is the status of concrete under BABAA—whether it is a BABAA-exempt or BABAA-covered construction material. AGC contends that Congress intended to exempt concrete, as it did with cement.

AGC Testifies Before Congress

On February 1, Jeff Firth, Vice-President of Hamilton Construction based in Oregon and Vice-Chair of AGC's Highway and Transportation Division, testified on behalf of AGC of America before the

Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and the ongoing challenges that inflation and supply chain constraints pose to the success of IIJA. He stressed that project costs continue to climb as material prices rise and many in the industry continue to face shortages and allocations.

In addition, he covered the uncertainty that the industry is facing as expanded Buy America requirements, included in IIJA, are being implemented and the significant confusion among federal, state, and local agencies on the specific requirements of the law. He also expressed concerns about the waiver process for materials as they now have to be approved not by a federal agency, but by the White House.

House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee members asked a variety of questions following the opening testimony. Firth had the opportunity to address challenges he and his company—like many other AGC members—have faced due to the federal environmental permitting process and stressed the need for a reform of the system in order to build and repair infrastructure in a timely and efficient manner.

Building a Better Congress
